Felimazole®

Treatment for feline hyperthyroidism. Inhibits the enzyme thyroid peroxidase to control excessive production of T3 and T4

Felimazole® contains thiamazole which is used for long-term treatment and/or stabilisation prior to surgical thyroidectomy. It has been treating cats with hyperthyroidism globally since 2002.

Hyperthyroidism is a multi-system disorder in cats caused by an increase in circulating concentrations of the thyroid hormones T3 and T4.

This is the most common feline endocrine disorder worldwide, it is estimated that over 10% of all senior cats will develop this disorder. Over 95% of affected cats have benign adenomatous hyperplasia of the thyroid gland, affecting either both lobes (70% cases) or one lobe (30% cases).

Felimazole® provides a treatment that can be delivered in small measured steps that take a giant leap towards a healthier life for the cat.

- Fully reversible.
- Flexible and precise dosing options with two dose strengths 2.5 and 5 mg, in packs of 100 tablets.
- Small and easy to swallow sugar coated tablets that can be used once or twice daily.
- For reasons of compliance, Felimazole® can be crushed (please read the fact sheet on our website for more information).

What dose to use?

- Recommended starting doses are 2.5 mg Felimazole® BID (5 mg SID if twice daily dosing is an issue). Adjust by 2.5 mg/day as needed.
