

How to shampoo your pet



Wet the coat & skin

Thoroughly wet the coat and skin surface with clean water that has a mild/moderate temperature making sure that plenty of water reaches the surface of the skin.

In a bottle, mix 4 parts water to 1 part shampoo. Diluted shampoo cuts through the coat easier, and is easier to rinse out.



Don't forget the paws

Shampoo each paw making sure to get in-between each digit (toe) and on/around the pad.



Apply our Mousse for water-less bathing if unable to shampoo





Apply shampoo

Apply shampoo to the most affected areas first, then gently massage shampoo into the coat and skin all over the pet, avoiding the ears, eyes, nose and mouth.

Using a sponge can make it easier to create a lather.



Rinse your pet

After the shampoo has been on the hair coat and skin for 10 minutes, thoroughly rinse your pet with clean mild temperature water. Allow your pet to shake itself, and then finish drying with a towel. Brush through coat and follow up with a spray conditioner against the hair grain for added benefit.
